Admission Requirements for RN-BSN

All applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Admission to Fayetteville State University.
 - a. Application deadlines are August 1 for August/Fall admission and January 10 for January/Spring admission.
- 2. Active and unencumbered RN license.
- 3. Evidence of an earned Associates Degree in Nursing or a Hospital Diploma in Nursing from an accredited program.
- 4. Submission of the RN to BSN Application to the School of Nursing.

Program Requirements

Core Requirements: Minimum of 32 credits in the core curriculum is required of all students. Program Admission Requirements: See Admission Requirements above.

Other Major Requirements: Grade of C or higher in all nursing courses.

Graduation Requirements: All graduating seniors are required to complete the Graduating Senior Assessment after completing 90 or more semester hours (including credit by examination), but not later than the graduation semester.
