



Help Your Students Get ready for Canvas! Canvas Student Orientation

Q: What is the Canvas Student Orientation?

The Canvas Student Orientation is an online course in Canvas that prepares students to successfully use Canvas for their online, hybrid, and traditional courses.

Q: If a student has taken the Canvas Student Orientation before, do they need to take it again?

No, the Canvas Student Orientation only needs to be completed once. If a student has completed the Orientation he/she will have a completion certificate to document their successful completion.

Q: How do students access the Canvas Student Orientation?

1. Access the My Bronco Portal: Go to the FSU webpage (www.uncfsu.edu) and click on the **My Bronco Portal** and login using your FSU username and password. Click Student Resources, and then **Canvas Student Orientation**.
2. Log into Canvas – Students should use their FSU username and password. After logging into Canvas, students should click Join Course or Enroll in Course to get started.

Q: How long should it take to complete the Canvas Student Orientation?

The time it takes to complete the Canvas Student Orientation depends on each individual student, but on average should take 1-2 hours. Students can work through the Orientation at their own pace and do not need to complete the Orientation all at once.

Q: What information is included in the Canvas Student Orientation?

The Canvas Student Orientation includes information about technology requirements, setting up individual profile and preferences, navigation, communication, turning in assignments, and checking grades in Canvas and many other important functions used by students.
