

**Course TimeLine: Bachelor of Arts English Literature and Language
Teaching/Licensure Concentration**

Please follow the recommendations listed below so as to graduate in four years' time with a North Carolina teaching license in Secondary English 9-12.

Year One: English 110, English 120, Two Science Courses (Scientific Literacy), One Math Course (Quantitative Reasoning), One Humanities and Creative Arts (Engl 220 or Engl 223 or Engl 240 or Engl 250 or Engl 253), Critical thinking or Philosophy (PHIL 110 or 220), One Global Literacy (ENGL 211 or ENGL 212), One Ethics and Civic Engagement (Educ 211)

Two Foreign Language Courses; they need not be the same language

Year Two: Engl 232 Film/Visual Literacy, EDUC 210 Educational Technology

One of the following: ENGL 211 World Literature I, ENGL 212 World Literature II, ENGL 310 Folklore

One of the following: ENGL 220 African/American Literature 1, ENGL 223 African/American Literature 2, Engl 240 Introduction to Literature

One of the following: ENGL 222 History of English Language, ENGL 230 Linguistics, ENGL 320 American English Dialect

EDUC 310 Foundations of Education

*Over the course of the second year, B.A. T/L C students must take and pass the Praxis I with a minimum composite score of 520: Reading 176 Writing 173 Mathematics 173

Year Four: ENGL 411 Shakespeare, ENGL 470 Senior Seminar, EDUC 421 Principles of Secondary Education, EDUC 450 Classroom Management, EDUC 460.03 Methods of Secondary English, High School Teaching

Final Semester: EDUC 480.05 Student Teaching, High School English (11 credits), EDUC 490 (1) credit.
