This is the verbiage that should be placed in all bids that will exceed \$10,000

QUALITY ACCEPTANCE INSPECTION: Upon completion of the project, as called for herein, the contractor must request a Quality Acceptance Inspection. Such requests must be forwarded (in writing) to the Division of Purchase and Contract, Attn: Quality Acceptance Inspections, 1305 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-1305. Fax # (919) 807-4511.

INVOICES WILL NOT BE PAID BY THE USING AGENCY UNTIL QUALITY ACCEPTANCE HAS BEEN ACCOMPLISHED.

This is the verbiage that should be placed in all bids in which the commodity being purchased runs on Electricity , propane or natural gas

THIRD PARTY CERTIFICATION: STANDARD LISTING CLAUSE.

See following for information requested. Use as deemed applicable to the equipment involved. Information provided is uncontrolled and to be maintained by the agency.

11. Also furnish the Section with a copy of the Contract Certification/Purchase Order at the time of distribution.
