Parade Line-Up on Hillsboro

The annual Fayetteville State University Homecoming Parade will be staged for line-up along the Hillsboro Street corridor from Rowan Street north to Ramsey Street. Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, Oct. 21st, parade personnel will be working along Hillsboro Street for set-up and the FSU Parade.

Line-Up and Parade - 6:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.

PLEASE BE MADE AWARE THAT . . .

- **Uniformed Police Officers will be on-site the entire length of Hillsboro Street.**
- **Every effort will be made not to block driveways along Hillsboro.**
- **Streets along the West side of Hillsboro will be blocked but accessible by residents.**
- **Streets along the East side of Hillsboro (toward Ramsey) will not be blocked.**
- **All traffic on Hillsboro will flow North, one way toward Ramsey Street.**
- **No traffic, except Parade, will be allowed on the South bound lanes of Hillsboro Street.**
- **Residents may enter and exit the area via side streets on Hillsboro toward Ramsey Street.**
- **Residents on the West side of Hillsboro toward FSU enter and exit with Police assistance.**
- **All Parade activity should be out of the Hillsboro Street area by approx 12:30 noon.**
- **If you have any problems, please look for Police Officer or Parade Personnel for assistance.**

Fayetteville State University and the City of Fayetteville will work to ensure that any disruption to Hillsboro area residents is minimal.
