

## **Implementation of Core Student Learning Outcomes**

### **AY 2007-08**

1. Faculty Senate approves proposed learning outcomes.
2. Departments submit to the Core Review Committee\* a list of all courses that enable students to achieve these outcomes. Departments are also invited to submit new courses to help students achieve these outcomes.
3. Based on information provided by departments, the Core Review Committee proposes structure for core curriculum.
4. Proposed structure with learning outcomes submitted for review by the Student Government Association.
5. Proposed structure submitted for review and/or approval to University College Advisory Board, Faculty Senate, Provost, and Chancellor.

### **AY 2008-09**

Division of Academic Affairs coordinates procedures for assessing core curriculum learning outcomes.

\*The Core Review Committee reports to the University College Advisory Board. It consists of three faculty members each from the College of Basic and Applied Sciences and the College of Humanities and Social Sciences; two faculty members each from the School of Education and the School of Business and Education; one representative each from the Faculty Senate, the University College, the Student Government Association, Student Affairs, and the University College Advisory Board. Deans and heads of units are responsible for recommending members from their units, but the manner of appointment is left to the discretion of the various schools and units.
