- ⇒ Guaranteed acceptance to FSU (as long as academic standards are maintained and financial obligations met).
- ⇒ Able to pursue Associate and Bachelor's degrees simultaneously.
- ⇒ Earn both the Associate's and Bachelor's degrees in as little as four years.
- ⇒ May be able to transfer a greater number of credit hours to Fayetteville State University.
- ⇒ Classes taken at both institutions are covered as long as you are eligible for financial aid.
- ⇒ Tuition cost may be less as more courses may be taken at the community college.
- ⇒ Advisors at both institutions.

## Student Responsibilities

- ⇒ Provide FSU and the Community College Admissions Department with completed application, and transcripts from all schools attended (college and high school/GED)
  - ⇒ You must be accepted at FSU before you can participate in this program. You will be notified by the Admissions Department at both institutions regarding your admissions decision.
  - ⇒ Ensure all financial aid information is turned in to FSU Financial Aid Office. Don't forget to put the FSU school code (002928) on your FAFSA
  - ⇒ Meet with FSU Community College Coordinator to determine the appropriate curriculum.
  - ⇒ Once accepted to both institutions, you may register for classes online during designated registration periods. You must communicate with your FSU advisor to obtain an alternate PIN for registration.
  - ⇒ Consult with the Community College registrar's office regarding their registration process.
- ⇒ You must complete a dual enrollment form, available on the Transfer and Advisement Website. The form has to be completed every semester that you plan to be dual enrolled.
  - ⇒ You are responsible for obtaining the appropriate signatures from the community college administrators. You will then forward the form to the FSU Community College Coordinator so that signatures may be obtained from the FSU administrators.
  - ⇒ At the end of each semester, you must submit a current community college transcript to the coordinator to ensure you receive credit for all classes taken. The coordinator will document classes and forward transcript to Registrar's Office.
  - ⇒ Financial aid refunds are processed by the Student Accounts Office. You may make arrangements to pick up your refund if applicable.
  - ⇒ You may need to pick up your books in person or make arrangements to have them mailed through the book store.
