To earn the B.S. Degree in Birth through Kindergarten Education, no more than 60 credit hours can be transferred in from a Community College unless the student is in a Dual Enrollment Plan. In addition, the student must complete the last 33 hours of the program and at least 50% (7 courses) of their Birth through Kindergarten Education core courses at Fayetteville State University.
