TIMELY WARNING NOTIFICATION
Possible Threat to the Community
“Your Right to Know”
November 4, 2016

Notice is being provided to the campus community of an alleged crime reported to have occurred on the Fayetteville State University campus.

On November 4, 2016, an alleged robbery of a student was reported to the University’s Police and Public Safety Department. According to reports, the incident occurred on Friday, November 4, 2016, at 12:38 a.m. near the Cook building toward Harris Hall. It was reported that 3 males assaulted the victim by punching him in the face and taking items belonging to the victim. The Suspects fled on foot toward Murchison Road.

The suspects’ descriptions are as follows:

Suspect #1 a black male, light skin, 5’10” tall with dreads, wearing blue hoody, blue shorts and blue sneakers.

Suspect#2 a black male, dark skin, 6’2” tall, short hair, red and black shirt, black pants and black shoes.

Suspect #3 a black male, dark skin, 6’ tall, black shirt, black pants.
