FSU Case 2017-0102135 TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLENTIN Possible Threat to the Community "Your Right to Know" January 20, 2017

Notice is being provided to the campus community of an alleged crime reported to have occurred on the Fayetteville State University campus.

On Friday, January 20, 2017, the Fayetteville State University Police Department was notified of an alleged common law robbery that occurred at approximately 11:01 p.m. The victim reported being approached by two suspects while in the gazebo area of campus. After speaking with the victim, one of the suspects punched the victim and stole a cellular telephone from the victim's possession. The suspects then fled the area on foot towards W.T. Brown Road.

Suspect #1 is described as black male, dark complexion, medium build, approximately 5'9", approximately late teens to early twenties, wearing a dark colored jacket, dark colored pants and a dark colored toboggan. The suspect was also described as having two gold colored "K-9" teeth on top and a gold colored "grill" covering a portion of his lower teeth.

Suspect #2 is described as a black male, brown-skinned, slim build, approximately 5'9", approximately late teens to early twenties, wearing a gray zip-up style hoodie, faded army type cargo pants and a grey colored toboggan.
