TIMELY WARNING NOTIFICATION
Possible Threat to the Community
“Your Right to Know”
October 28, 2016

Notice is being provided to the campus community of an alleged crime reported to have occurred near the Fayetteville State University campus.

On October 27, 2016, an alleged robbery of an individual was reported to the University’s Police and Public Safety Department. According to reports, the incident occurred on Thursday, October 27, 2016, at 11:03 p.m. near the Bronco statue located near Bryant Hall. It was reported that approximately 10-15 males surrounded a male victim while one of the individuals struck the victim with a closed fist. While the victim laid on the ground, an unknown person(s) stole the victim’s belongings. The suspects were last seen fleeing north bound on foot toward MLK Drive near Capel Arena.

The suspects’ descriptions are as follows:

Suspect 1: Black male, approximately 6’, unknown weight and age, wearing a black Duke Blue Devil hooded jacket.

Other suspects: Black males, unknown height, weight, age and clothing description.
