FSU Case 2017-0203637 TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLENTIN Possible Threat to the Community "Your Right to Know" February 4, 2017

Notice is being provided to the campus community of an alleged crime reported to have occurred on the Fayetteville State University campus.

On Saturday, February 04, 2017, the Fayetteville State University Police Department was notified of an alleged sexual battery that occurred at approximately 4:45 a.m. The victim reported that while in the parking lot of the University Place Apartments, she was approached by the suspect, who began to speak with her. During the conversation, the victim turned her back to the suspect, who lifted the victim's clothing and fondled her buttocks. Afterwards, the suspect propositioned the victim to engage in sexual acts. The victim returned to her vehicle and later notified the FSU Police Department of the incident. The suspect left the area in the vehicle described below.

Suspect #1 is described as a black male, heavy set build, approximately 280 pounds, approximately 5'9", approximately 30-40 years of age, clean shaven with medium length to long dreads. The suspect was wearing black in color sweat pants, a gray long sleeve T-shirt, and a pair of socks.

Suspect Vehicle is described as an older model white in color tow truck with chrome type wheels. The tow truck had a quick lift attachment on the back of the truck. The tow truck also had writing on the door of the truck.
