- Of the 2017-2018 graduates, the three most popular undergraduate majors were Bachelor of Science in Nursing (203), Bachelor of Science in Psychology (136), and Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice (119).
- The top three master's programs were Master of Social Work (64), Master of Business Administration (60), and Master of Educational Leadership and Administration (13).

## **FACULTY AND STAFF (Preliminary)**

- 267 full-time and 79 part-time teaching faculty (using AAUP criteria) are employed as of October 1, 2018.
- 190 faculty members are female and 165 are male.
- 219 faculty members are minorities and 122 are non-minorities.
- 77% of full-time faculty members hold doctoral or first professional degrees.
- The average salary of a full-time faculty member (using AAUP) is \$83,099 for men and \$78,879 for women.
- Student-to-faculty ratio is approximately 17 to 1.
- 552 staff members (550 full-time and 2 part-time) are employed as of October 1, 2018.
- 350 staff members are females and 202 are males.
- 463 staff members are minorities and 79 are non-minorities.
