- Of the 2018-2019 graduates, the three most popular undergraduate majors were Bachelor of Science in Nursing (183), Bachelor of Science in Psychology (149), and Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (103).
- The top three master's programs were Master of Business Administration (105), Master of Social Work (39), and Master of Educational Leadership and Administration (23).

FACULTY AND STAFF (Preliminary)

- 269 full-time and 73 part-time teaching faculty (using AAUP criteria) are employed as of October 1, 2019.
- 179 faculty members are female and 163 are male.
- 202 faculty members are minorities and 120 are non-minorities.
- 71% of full-time faculty members hold doctoral or first professional degrees.
- The average salary of a full-time faculty member (using AAUP) is \$84,682 for men and \$78,641 for women.
- Student-to-faculty ratio is approximately 18 to 1.
- 519 staff members (515 full-time and 4 part-time) are employed as of October 1, 2019.
- 334 staff members are females and 185 are males.
- 436 staff members are minorities and 69 are non-minorities.
