- Of 23 graduate programs, the top three were Education (41), Social Work (40), and School Administration (27).

- 235 full-time teaching faculty (using CUPA- HR criteria) are employed as of October 1, 2007.
- 82% of full-time faculty members hold doctoral or first professional degrees.
- The average salary of a full-time faculty member is \$65,359 for men and \$59,819 for women.
- Student-to-faculty ratio is approximately 18 to 1.
