- Of the 2011-12 graduates, the three most popular undergraduate majors were Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice (157), Bachelor of Science in Psychology (154), and Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (136).
- Of 20 master's programs, the top three were Master of Social Work (60), Master of Education in Teacher Education and Professional Development (25), and Master of Business Administration (19).

#### FACULTY AND STAFF

- 277 full-time teaching faculty (using AAUP criteria) are employed as of October 1, 2012.
- 88% of full-time faculty members hold doctoral or first professional degrees.
- The average salary of a full-time faculty member is \$74,344 for men and \$72,467 for women.
- Student-to-faculty ratio is approximately 16 to 1.
