- The top three master's programs were Master of Social Work (95), Master of Business Administration (29), and Master of Education (25).

FACULTY AND STAFF

- 242 full-time teaching faculty (using AAUP criteria) are employed as of October 1, 2014.
- 86% of full-time faculty members hold doctoral or first professional degrees.
- The average salary of a full-time faculty member is \$74,469 for men and \$74,313 for women.
- Student-to-faculty ratio is approximately 18 to 1.
