Note: In order to apply for your license in Health & Physical Education (K - 12) you must take and successfully pass the PRAXIS II Health & Physical Education: Content Knowledge exam and edTPA (Task 1, 2, & 3).

Candidates who are not currently employed as a Residency Licensure teacher must be placed in a public school classroom by the College of Education's Office of Teacher Education.
