  - 3.2.** **Core Quantitative Reason.** MATH 123 Or MATH 126 Or MATH 129 Or MATH 130 Or MATH 131 Or MATH 140 Or POLI 240 Or STAT 202 . MATH 121 may be required based on profile scores. Some core courses require a one-hour lab.
  - 4.** **Core Info Literacy.** ENGL 120 .
