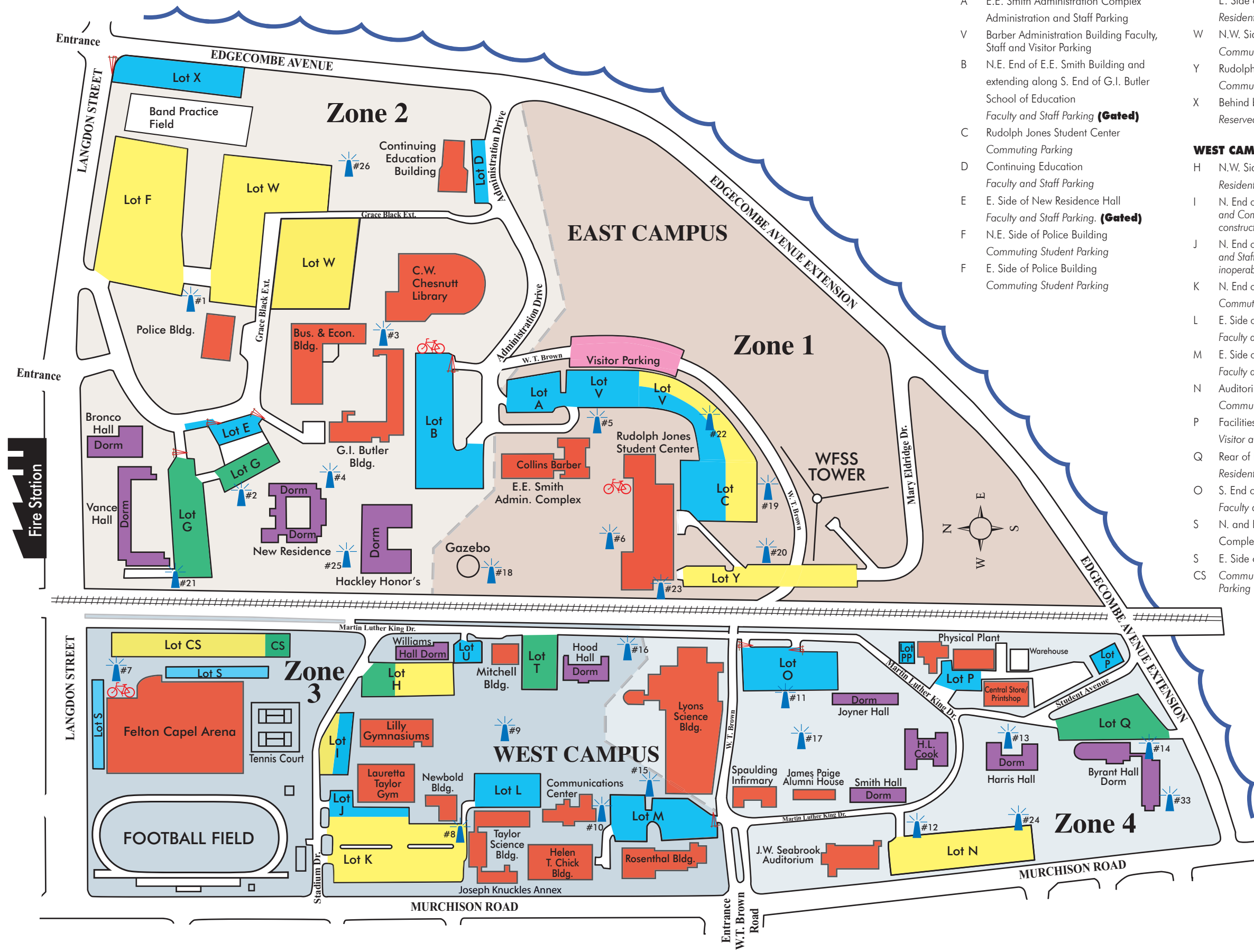

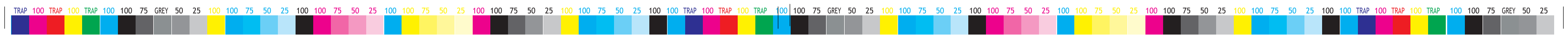

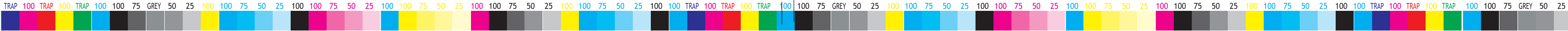

Motorists with vehicles requiring a jump start may contact the FSU Police for assistance 24 hours a day 7 days a week by using an emergency call box or by calling 672-1911. This is a cost-free service provided by the Police Department. A liability waiver must be signed before service is rendered.

MOTORIST ASSISTANCE

Handicapped faculty, staff, or students must purchase an FSU parking permit and park in designated handicapped spaces within their assigned zone. Such persons must display the State of North Carolina Handicapped License Plate in addition to the FSU permit. Persons temporarily handicapped by illness or injury may be issued special temporary handicapped permits allowing them to park in designated handicapped spaces.

HANDICAPPED PERMITS

Temporary permits for conference parking are available to departments for meetings, seminars, or workshops. Arrangements for such permits should be made with the Traffic and Parking clerk at 672-1726.

TEMPORARY PERMITS

Temporary permits are available for up to two weeks to persons without registered cars for a fee of \$5.00 per week. Fees paid for temporary permits do not apply to permanent permit fees.

CONFERENCE PARKING

Short-term visitor parking is available on W.T. Brown Road next to the E.E. Smith Administration Complex. Visitors should go to the Police Department to obtain a temporary visitor permit.

VISITOR PARKING

University parking areas are zoned, reserved, and/or restricted. Refer to the map on the reverse side for zone designations. Parking is prohibited except in lots, streets, and areas indicated. Legal parking at all times is restricted to spaced marked for parking.

PARKING SPACES ARE AVAILABLE ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS.

As of January 1, 2002, North Carolina General Statutes required that all students provide the company name and policy number for any motor vehicle to be issued a permit by one of the constituent institutions of University of North Carolina.

PERMIT FEES

Permits must be clearly visible at all times. Permits should be hung from the rear view mirror or placed on the lower left inside windshield on the dashboard. Permits are not permanently affixed to the vehicle. Permit holders are responsible for keeping vehicles locked at all times to prevent permit theft. Replacements for stolen permits may be obtained only upon payment of a \$15 fee and completion of an official State of North Carolina stolen property police report. Filing of a falsified police report is a crime.

PERMIT DISPLAY

Permits may be picked up between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Police Department.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION

All students and employees, whether full time or part time, must register vehicles driven on campus. No student or employee may register a vehicle which is not owned by him or her or his or her spouse, children, parent, or guardian. A vehicle is considered registered only when the permit is displayed. Every FSU employee authorized to hire temporary or part time employees is responsible for informing such employees to register their vehicles. Vehicles may be registered online at <http://www.unctsu.edu/police/parking.htm>. Permits may be picked up between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Police Department.

ENFORCEMENT

PAYMENT OF FINES

Payment of fines may be made by check or money order, payable to FSU. Payment of fines may be made at the Cashier's Office or may be accepted by the Traffic / Parking Clerk, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Payment may also be made by U.S. Mail. Parking citations not paid within 72 hours are considered delinquent and the fine will double. Delinquent citations will be sent to the FSU Business Office for collection.

FACULTY, STAFF, AND STUDENT PARKING

REPORTING ACCIDENTS

North Carolina laws requires that any vehicular accident involving bodily injury or damage to one or more vehicles in excess of \$1000 must be reported to the law enforcement agency within whose jurisdiction for such reporting on the campus of Fayetteville State University. Call 672-1911 to report a motor vehicle accident.

APPEALS

Parking citations may be appealed in writing or in person to a member of the Traffic Division within ten (10) days of issuance of citation. Appointments for in-person appeals should be made through the Department Traffic Division.

NO APPEAL FOR HANDICAPPED OR FIRE LANE CITATIONS

WEAPONS ON CAMPUS

North Carolina laws allowing citizens to carry concealed weapons became effective December 1,1995. These laws do not affect the existing North Carolina laws prohibiting the possession of firearms on campuses. Possession of a firearm on the campus of Fayetteville State University, with or without a valid concealed weapons permit, is a felony.
