Effective Fall Semester 2006, Fayetteville State University will no longer offer an internal payment plan. Students with balances \$100 or greater wishing to make payments must enroll through Tuition Management Systems (TMS). Fayetteville State University's housing cost is \$1,435.00 per semester for the regular residence halls and \$1,510.00 for the suite-style dormitory. Fayetteville State University offers the following meal plans: A twenty-one (21 meals per week) meal plan is required for all first-time freshman residing in our residence halls at a cost of \$1,070 per semester (plus \$100.00 in declining balance per year). All other students residing on campus may choose from the twenty-one (21) meal plan at a cost of \$1,070 per semester (plus \$100.00 in declining balance per year), a seventeen (17) meal plan at a cost of \$1,017.00 per semester (plus \$120.00 in declining balance per year) or a fourteen (14) meal plan at a cost of \$963.00 per semester (plus \$140.00 declining balance per year).

Commuting students may now enroll in a \$300 per year declining balance plan, which allows you to eat at any food venue on campus, as well as the 21, 17 or 14 meals per week plans. In addition, commuting students may also choose from a 60-Block Meal Plan (\$335.00 plus \$100.00 declining balance per year), a 40-Block Meal Plan (\$235.00 plus \$80 declining balance per year) or a 20-Block Meal Plan (\$130.00 plus \$60 declining balance per year), provided by the Food Services Contractor, for meals served in the main dining facility.

Payments can be made by cash, cashier's check, personal check, money orders, Visa/MasterCard or Financial Aid Award letters.

**Students with a bill of \$100 or more must pay their bills in full by the last day of registration.**

**Students with an account balance after the last day of registration and are not identified by Tuition Management Systems with a current payment plan, will automatically be charged a service fee and placed on TMS's Monthly Payment Plan. In order to offer more payment flexibility, it is recommended students not receiving financial aid payment to cover all tuition/fees and unable to pay in full by the last day of registration contact TMS to set up a payment plan today!
