Call to Order

Attendees received a folder containing the meeting agenda and appeal records. The Executive Committee meeting of the Graduate Council of the Fayetteville State University Graduate School was called to order by Dr. LaDelle Olion, Chair.

Dr. Olion stated that after two failed attempts to obtain a quorum of the Graduate Council the Executive Committee was convened in order to respond to student appeals.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the June 8th and August 25th Executive Committee meeting were reviewed. Dr. Wilson moved to approve the minutes; Dr. Kamalu seconded and the minutes were approved.

Appeals

1. ██████████ submitted a request for readmission into the MBA Program and to retake one of three "C" grade classes. Dr. Wilson made a motion to accept the recommendation of the Admissions Committee which was to accept the recommendation of the MBA Admissions committee with the condition that ██████████: 1) withdraw from current Fall 2009 term classes; 2) retake either MIS 620 or FINC 610 and receive a "B" or higher and 3) she not be allowed to take additional courses until item (2) above has been completed; Dr. Hicks seconded and there being no opposition, the motion was approved.
2. ██████████ submitted a request to be allowed reinstatement into the MSCJ Program and to repeat courses with a "C" grade. Dr. Hicks made a motion to approved the recommendation of the Admissions Committee which was to approve the request with the condition that ██████████ retake either CRJC 520 or CRJC 510 and earn a "B" or better in the course to remain in the program and that he retake one of these courses before taking any other graduate course. Also, it was recommended that ██████████ be encouraged to take a business writing class. Dr. Wilson seconded the motion and there being no opposition, the motion was approved.

3. ██████████ submitted a request to be allowed reinstatement into the SWK Program and to repeat courses with a "C" grade. Dr. Wilson made a motion to accept the recommendation of the Admissions Committee which was to concur with the response from the Social Work Department to deny the appeal; Dr. Hicks seconded and there being no opposition, the motion to deny was approved.
4. ██████████ submitted a request for an exception to the GPA requirement and admission to the MSW Program. Dr. Wilson made a motion to approve the request based on the support received from the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, the Department Chair and faculty members; Dr. Hicks seconded and there being no opposition, the motion was approved.
5. ██████████ submitted a request for a one-year extension in the Sociology Graduate Program. The committee agreed that there was very little information and no support provided. Dr. Wilson made a motion to table the appeal until more information was provided; Dr. Kamalu seconded and there being no opposition, the motion was approved.
6. ██████████ submitted a request to extend the period of her Internship completion in the Counseling Psychology Program to Spring Term 2010. Dr. Wilson made a motion to approve the request based on the support from the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, the Graduate Coordinator and the Department Chair; Dr. Barringer-Brown seconded and there being no opposition, the motion was approved.
7. ██████████ submitted a request to extend the period of her Internship completion in the Counseling Psychology Program to Spring Term 2010. Dr. Barringer-Brown made a motion to approve the request based on the support from the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, the Graduate Coordinator and the Department Chair; Dr. Wilson seconded and there being no opposition, the motion was approved.
8. ██████████ submitted a request to withdraw six hours of Theses HIST691 so that he could continue in the program and complete the non-thesis degree requirements. Dr. Kamalu made a motion to approve the request; Dr. Barringer-Brown seconded. One member abstained and the motion was approved.

Adjournment

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned.
