The Programs and Curriculum Review Committee met to review and make a recommendation on the following proposal: Curriculum Revision to the Sociology M.A. Program.

As members of the sociology department faculty, Dr. Aghajanian and, Dr. Druann Heckert explained the revised proposal and were available for questions.

At the request of Dr. Ngozi Kamalu, Chair of the Programs and Curriculum Review Committee, Dr. Aghajanian made a motion to approve and recommend for approval the proposal which is to offer another option to meet the degree requirements for the Master of Arts program in sociology by adding a 36-credit non-thesis/non-practicum (i.e., requiring six additional credits in lieu of the thesis or practicum) as well as a written comprehensive examination. Dr. Pitre seconded and the motion passed with no opposition.
