APPEAL REQUEST	RECOMMENDATION
Requesting reinstatement as a graduate student into the Licensure Only program for Middle Grades Language Arts.	(Motion by Dr. Harvey; seconded by Dr. Okhomina) Recommended that student be readmitted to Licensure Program contingent upon retaking READ 320 and EDUC461 if “D” grade should have been “F” grade. (Dr. Olion to check on status)
Requesting readmission to MS in Biology program and permission to retake BIOL 640 (or equivalent) due to “F” grade.	(Motion by Dr. Harvey; seconded by Dr. Okhomina) Recommended approval of request for readmission and permission to retake BIOL 640 (or equivalent) due to “F” grade.
Requesting reinstatement and permission to retake SOCI 422 due to “C” grade	(Motion by Dr. Harvey; seconded by Dr. Okhomina). Recommended that student be readmitted with condition student retake one of three classes (SOCI422, CRJC600, SOCI590) with “C” grade.
Requesting to take BADM 530 (replaces BADM 591/592) due to “IP” grade in BADM 591/592.	(Motion by Dr. Harvey; seconded by Dr. Okhomina) Recommended tabling due to insufficient information.
Requesting that ENGL 431 not be counted against her and to be reinstated into the MA in Teaching for Middle Grades Language Arts degree program.	(Motion by Dr. Harvey; seconded by Dr. Okhomina) Recommend student be reinstated and that undergraduate class ENGL 431 not count against the graduate program.
