

Senior Request to Pursue Graduate Level Courses

Fayetteville State University students with senior classification in the College of Arts and Sciences and the School of Education may be permitted to enroll in 500 level courses. Students in the School of Business and Economics with senior classification may be permitted to register for 500 and 600 level courses.

Seniors must meet the following criteria to be permitted to register for graduate level courses:

- 1) Receive approval of advisor, department chair, dean of the school or college in which student is pursuing the major and the Dean of The Graduate School.
- 2) Maintain Grade-Point-Average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
- 3) Be eligible for graduation during the academic year in which the student is registered for graduate courses.

Please note:

- Graduate level courses taken to fulfill undergraduate degree requirements will not be recognized by the university to fulfill graduate degree requirements.
- Undergraduate students registered for the graduate courses may not take more than fifteen (15) hours per semester during the regular academic year or more than nine (9) hours per semester during a summer session.
- Students cannot pursue a graduate and an undergraduate degree during the same semester.
