

**Fayetteville State University
and
Hebei Normal University
Articulation Agreement**


1. Fayetteville State University is hereafter referred to as FSU, and Hebei Normal University is hereafter referred to as HNU.
2. FSU does hereby agree to admit students sent by HNU to be educated for a period of time sufficient to earn a bachelor's and/or master's degree and/or doctoral degree. The number of students will be mutually agreed upon by FSU and HNU. Students shall meet all admission and registration requirements for international students as described in the current FSU undergraduate/graduate catalog.
3. HNU does hereby agree to recommend well-qualified students who meet FSU's admission requirements and who are eligible for F-1 or J-1 visa status. The undergraduate students must have a TOEFL score at or above the minimum requirement set by FSU before being admitted to FSU. The graduate students must have an appropriate GRE or GMAT score at or above the minimum requirement set by FSU before being admitted to FSU. These students must submit all application forms and appropriate documentations as indicated in the FSU catalog to the university's Admissions Office.
4. FSU does hereby agree to expedite all applications from HNU and assist in resolving any individual questions or problems that might arise regarding the application/registration process, subject to published deadline dates.
5. FSU does hereby agree to accept the transfer credits from HNU for courses that FSU identifies as having content equivalent to courses taught at FSU.
6. HNU does hereby agree to inform HNU students of their full responsibility for the payment of tuition and fees, book costs, living expenses, travel, and any other expenses that may arise during their stay at FSU. HNU also agrees to have each student to purchase appropriate medical coverage required by FSU.
7. FSU does hereby agree to provide academic and life counseling to students from HNU. The Assistant Vice Chancellor for International Education or another university official will direct the HNU students to the appropriate offices for appropriate counseling regarding academic courses and living arrangements while studying at FSU.
8. Upon receiving a signed release from a student, FSU does hereby agree to provide HNU with information concerning the academic performance of the students.
9. FSU does hereby agree to encourage its students to participate in both short and long term study at HNU.

10. This Agreement will be subject to annual review at both institutions. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by giving at least one (1) year's notice in writing to the other party.
11. This Agreement shall be effective for a period of five (5) years, starting on the day of signing by the President of HNU and the Chancellor of FSU.


Further details of this Articulation Agreement shall be worked out through mutual consultation.
