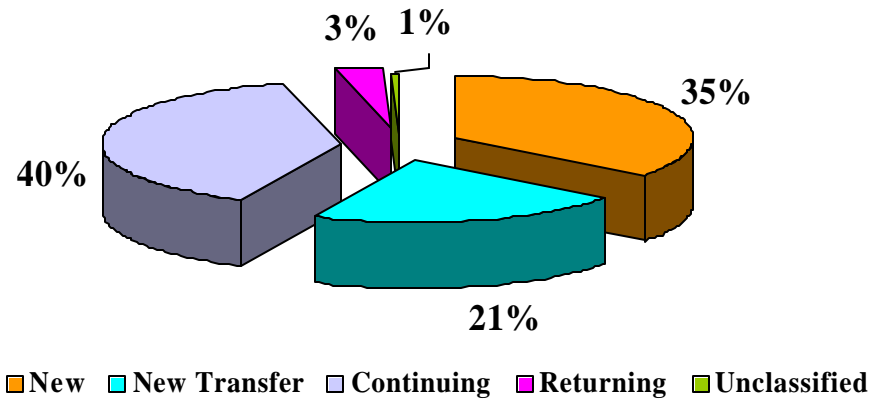


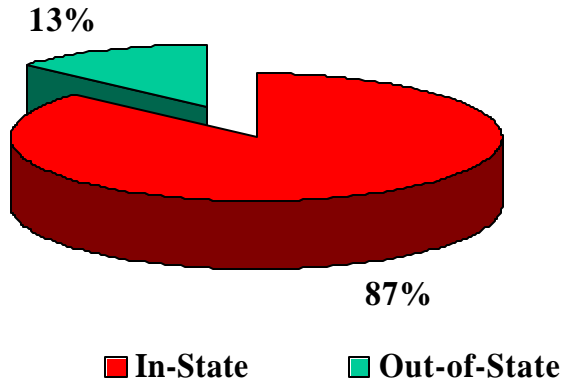

Fall 2003**

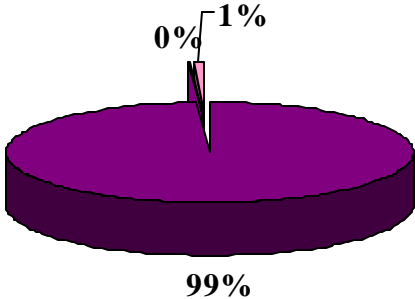

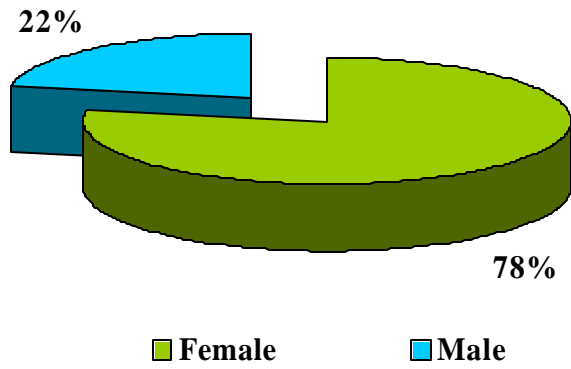


■ US Citizen ■ Non-Resident Alien ■ Resident Alien

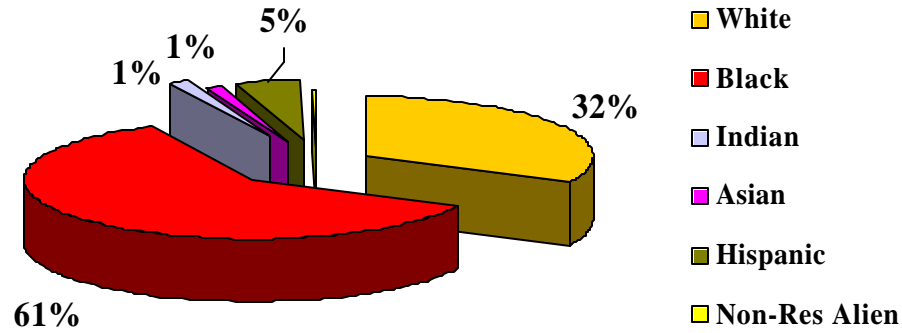

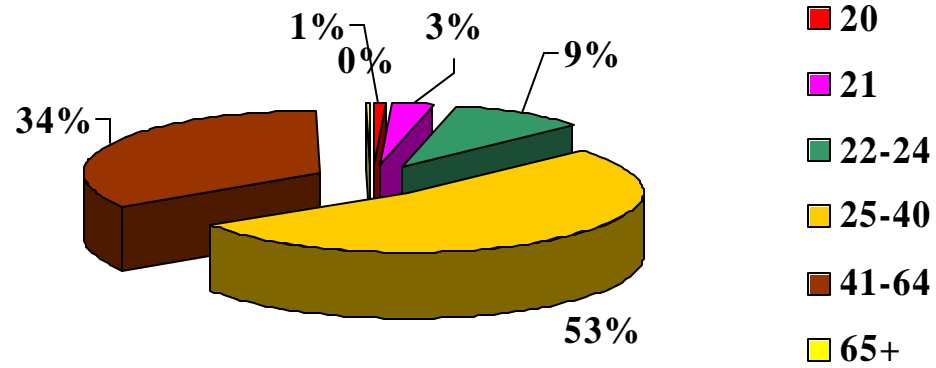

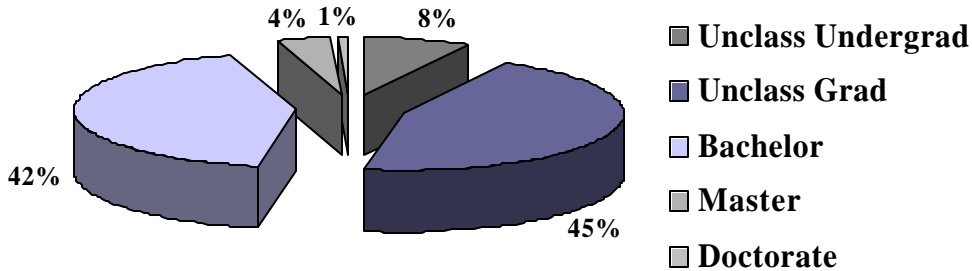

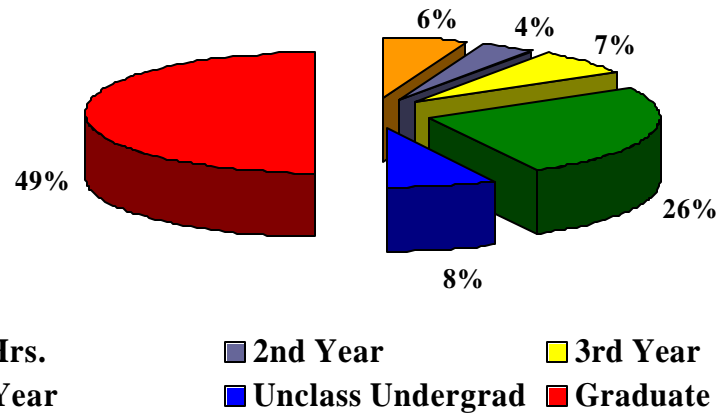

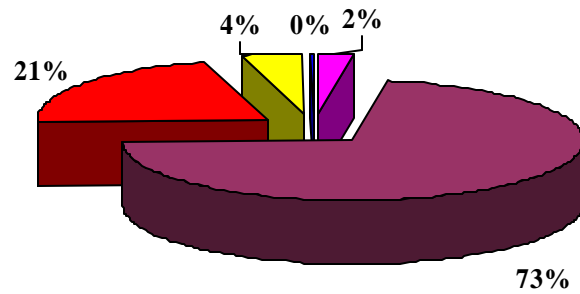
