

Fayetteville State University – Faculty Position

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Fayetteville State University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor in Mathematics starting August 2008. Fayetteville State University is a constituent institution of the University of North Carolina and the second-oldest public institution of higher education in the state.

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science offers bachelor's degrees in Mathematics, Mathematics Secondary Education, and Computer Science, and Master's degrees in Mathematics and Teaching Mathematics. Applicants must have a PhD in pure Mathematics, a strong commitment to teaching, a minimum of 1-2 year teaching experiences in college level, ability to teach mathematics at all levels, and effective communication and interpersonal skills.

Responsibilities of faculty include teaching a wide variety of undergraduate and graduate courses in mathematics and statistics, research and publication, and service to the department, college, and university. Salary and rank are negotiable and commensurate with qualifications and experience.
