FACULTY RESEARCH MENTOR CRITERIA

- Must be able to design a project that may be completed in eight (8) weeks.
- Willing to mentor two (2) students, if necessary
- Commitment during the time period indicated
- Ensure weekly submission of timesheets indicating time mentee devoted to project
- Assist student with submission of four (4) week progress report and final report
- Assist student with presentation/demonstration at closing ceremony

TO APPLY

- Submit project summary (more than one if able to mentor two (2) students)
hypothesis, statement of problem, research objectives/goals
- Submit project description (to include the following)
experimental design, weekly timeline, requested supplies/software with appropriate justification
