TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLETIN
Possible Threat to the Community
“Your Right to Know”
December 15, 2008

In compliance with the provisions of the federal **Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998**, the Fayetteville State University (FSU) Campus Police are giving notice of an alleged disturbing act of violence reported to have occurred on the campus of Fayetteville State University.

On Monday, December 15, 2008, an alleged armed robbery of two individuals was reported to campus police and administrators. The incident allegedly occurred on Monday, December 15, 2008, at approximately 11:50 p.m. while a Fayetteville State University student and an acquaintance of the student were in a parking lot on the campus of Fayetteville State University. The victims reported that while they were in a parking lot on the Fayetteville State University campus, two unknown males approached them. The victims reported that the one of the males pointed a gun at them and demanded money. The victims reported that after the males robbed them of their property, the suspects ran from the area.

The victims reported the following information regarding the suspects.

Suspect 1: Black male, approximately 6’1”, wearing a mask.

Suspect 2: Black male, approximately 5’8”, wearing a mask.

Anonymous information is welcomed. The university has an “affirmative duty” to warn persons associated with this university of possible peril at the hands of some third party or parties.

Students, staff, and faculty should carefully consider their surroundings and stay cognizant of those around them. Students, staff, and faculty are encouraged to walk in groups and walk in well lit, frequently traveled areas.
