On-line teaching will be a part of the teaching load for all these tenure track positions. **Positions 4 & 5. Assistant/Associate Professor in Counseling/Clinical Psychology.**

Candidates must have a Ph.D. degree in counseling or clinical psychology and an internship from an APA-accredited program. Candidates must have demonstrated commitment to effective undergraduate and graduate teaching in a variety of psychology courses with a diverse student body. Responsibilities will include mentoring student research and academic advising. Candidate should also have an active research program that will involve undergraduate and graduate students. Preference will be given to candidates who are licensed or license-eligible as a psychologist in North Carolina. The department is in the early stages of planning a doctoral program (contingent upon university and governing board approval) that will emphasize rural mental health interventions and concomitant research with military families and disenfranchised populations including minorities experiencing inequities. The successful candidate will be expected to facilitate the process of building this program.
