

DEPARTMENT CHAIR. Fayetteville State University, a member institution of the 17-campus University of North Carolina system, seeks a visionary and highly innovative Chair to lead a psychology department currently consisting of fifteen tenured and tenure-track faculty, 40 graduate students in two master's programs (counseling and experimental), and 483 undergraduate majors. The department is in the early stages of planning a doctoral program (contingent upon university and governing board approval) that will emphasize mental health counseling and research with military families and minority populations. The successful candidate will be expected to play a significant role in the building and leading of this program.

Current faculty members have scholarly interests in many subfields of psychology including counseling, social, developmental, biopsychology, experimental, and health. The university encourages multidisciplinary programs and research bolstered by many complementary programs in the social and natural sciences. The position start-date is August 1, 2011 and applications will be reviewed until the position is filled. The salary is highly competitive and will be commensurate with the credentials and experience of the applicants.
