A completed application consists of the following: ☐ Graduate <u>application</u> and fee ☐ Minimum graduate GPA of 3.50 ☐ Official transcripts of all college/university work ☐ GRE score no more than five (5) years old (waived if student holds two (2) master's degrees) ☐ A portfolio of professional growth ☐ Three professional letters of recommendation (not older than two years) ☐ A personal interview ☐ An on-demand writing sample ☐ Complete all requirements for the safety review. The campus safety requirement will NOT be bypassed under any circumstances The professional growth portfolio must include: ☐ Resume/ CV ☐ A Statement of Purpose ☐ Evidence of leadership initiatives and potential (e.g. certificates, research, publications, workshops, presentations, programs) Please mail or email portfolios to:
