VACOM Fellows Program

VACOM FELLOWS

The VACOM Fellows program is open to nurses who currently work in communitybased/primary care clinical agencies. VACOM Fellow participants will receive continuing education as well as monetary compensation for their time. VACOM Fellows can also function as preceptors for students who participate in the VACOM program. Preceptors oversee the clincal experiences of VACOM students within the primary care setting. The goal of the VACOM program is to create a sustainable community health workforce with the guidance of certified primary care nurses. If you are passionate about broadening community-based care the VACOM Fellows program may be for you.

FREE CERTIFICATION

VACOM Fellows have access to a free online self-paced community-based/primary care program. This program consists of 5 learning modules. Participants have 6 months to complete this learning and will receive 5 CEUS or 50 contact hours. VACOM Fellows are also eligible for the Practice in Military Culture certification. This course provides insight into military culture and the special needs of veterans and their families.

MONETARY COMPENSATION

Community members who participate in the VACOM program will receive a payment of \$1,000 after obtaining certification.
