



ARMY ROTC Green to Gold Program

The Green to Gold program seeks talented young active duty enlisted soldiers with officer potential to voluntarily request discharge from active duty (program dependent- see options below) and enroll in ARMY ROTC to earn a baccalaureate or master's degree and receive a commission as a second lieutenant.

Basic Eligibility

- Citizenship: Must be a U.S. citizen
- Age: You must be commissioned before 30 years of age; 30 years old and above requires a waiver.
- > Time-in-service: At least 2 years, no more than 10 (waiver possible), Active duty program (less than eight years active-waiver possible)
- Must be eligible to reenlist (no flags)
- > GT Score: 110 or higher
- > GPA: 2.5 or higher (2.0 or higher for non-scholarship applicants)
- **➤** No civil convictions (waiver possible)
- Strong, positive recommendation from Chain of Command
- Pass commissioning physical (no permanent profiles)
- ➤ No more than three dependents (waiver possible)
- Single parents and dual military require a waiver
- Pass the Army Fitness Test (ACFT)

OPTIONS

- Scholarship: 2, 3, or 4-year scholarships available
- Non-scholarship: 2 years only **Note: non-scholarship can join Guard or Reserves under Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP)
- Active Duty Option: Remain on active duty (two-year option only) Note: Can attend any school that has an ARMY ROTC program

SCHOLARSHIP

ROTC Scholarship pays for tuition (up to full tuition and fees), provides for books and supplies (\$1,200/year) and \$420 a month tax-free stipend while in school. GI Bill and/or College Fund can be used if eligible (at least 36 months served on active duty for 3 year or more enlistment). Some schools offer other incentives such as room and board endowment scholarships.

Commitment

After commissioning as a 2LT, you must serve 8 years in the military with a minimum of 3 years AD; the rest may be served in the reserves.

Non-Scholarship Packet

***Turn all items listed below to your local ROTC Recruiting Officer (James Salanitro). He will verify and then guide you through the discharge process.

- Complete CC form 139R (page 1&2). Located at: https://www.campbell.edu/rotc/recruitment/rotc-contracting-packet/
- Request a DODMERB physical... this can be done through your local ROTC Recruiting Officer by submitting a CC 139R.
 - Once the request is submitted you will be notified to complete the exam with a local civilian doctor (contracted by the Army). The exam will be sent to, and approved by DODMERB.

- Letter of acceptance from the university
 - o Must state you are an academic junior or graduate student
 - Must state start date of school
- CC form 104R completed (academic plan)
 - o Must be signed by your school academic advisor (page 1) and PMS (page 3)
 - You must also sign page 1&3
 - O You must be able to finish school in two years (four academic semesters).
- DA form 705 (ACFT)
 - With in 6 months
- Soldier Talent Profile or SRB
 - o GT score above 110
 - o BASD shows more than two years and less than 10 years active duty served (can be waived).
 - o No more than three dependents and not dual military with dependents (can be waived).
- Verification of citizenship (original birth cert. or unexpired passport)
 - Naturalized citizens and all others that are considered English as a second language must pass the ECLT (English Comprehension Level Test) at 90% or higher; this includes those born in Puerto Rico. The Test Center number is (910) 907-3926.
- All college transcripts showing a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
- CC form 228R (financial plan)
- Letters of recommendation from your company and battalion commander.
- Letter of acceptance from the Professor of Military Science (PMS) at your ROTC program.

***Note: All require waivers must be approved prior to initiating discharge (i.e. Age, dependency, Active Federal Service, Civil Conviction, Training Service Obligation, etc...).

• DA 4187 is required for each waiver w/supporting documents.
