#### **Background**

The University of North Carolina Board of Governors adopted **Section 300.8.5 of the UNC Policy Manual**, *Equality Within the University of North Carolina*, on May 23, 2024, to reaffirm the University's longstanding commitment to equality.

In the first year, we completed the **2024 Equality Policy Certification**, which included an initial assessment of Diversity & Inclusion positions across the institution, review of terminology of the university's website, and an evaluation of selected areas within Student Affairs and Human Resources.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR 2025-26**
