COMMITTEE ON UNIVERSITY ADVANCEMENT

The Committee on University Advancement of the Fayetteville State University Board of Trustees convened Wednesday, September 25, 2024, in the Rudolph Jones Student Center, Multi-purpose Room 242 and via Microsoft Teams. The meeting was called to order by Trustee Greg Pinnix at 11:17 AM.

ROLL CALL

The following trustees were in attendance: Mr. Gregory Pinnix, Mrs. Joyce Adams, Dr. Warren McDonald, and Dr. Kimberly Jeffries Leonard.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

It was moved by Trustee McDonald and seconded by Trustee Joyce Adams that the minutes of the Committee on University Advancement Meeting held on June 12, 2024, be accepted as printed. The motion carried.

UNIVERSITY ADVANCEMENT UPDATES

Mr. Omar Bell, Vice Chancellor for University Advancement, provided an update on fundraising engagement.

- The university raised \$9.3 million dollars in fiscal year 2024 (FY24).
 - o Over \$6.6 million in cash | Over \$2.6 million committed.
- Overall FY24 alumni donor participation reached 5.3%.
- FY25 total raised to date is \$3.5 million dollars.
 - This total is about \$1 million ahead of last year's total for this period.

The Office of Alumni Affairs will focus on engagement, communication, and chapter visits. The FY25 goal for alumni participation is 7%. The FSU Future Alumni Association has been revived and an executive board established. Helping students understand they are alumni in the making is a priority.

The Office of Development, under the leadership of Associate Vice Chancellor Sandy Yates, now has three frontline fundraisers. The fundraisers are Doris Pierce Hardy (director), Angel Parks (associate director), and Caleb Heatwole '21 (assistant director). The gift processor, Tiffani Baker, ensures incoming gifts to the university get to their designated destination.

Jose Carnero is the director of advancement services. Grover Richardson is the prospect researcher.

The strategic focus for the division entails the following:

- Staff metrics raising dollars; strengthening relationships for increased participation
- Data analytics improving automation; holding focus groups
- Building qualified portfolios strategic solicitations; ongoing visits and engagement

In advancing the university, staff will work to make planned giving marketing stronger, invite constituents to be a part of FSU happenings not just give, send out an annual fall appeal, strive to increase alumni participation to 7%, and continue donor mining.
