COMMITTEE ON ATHLETICS

Wednesday, December 7, 2022

The Committee on Athletics of the Fayetteville State University Board of Trustees convened on Wednesday, December 7, 2022, in the Rudolph Jones Student Center, Multi-Purpose Room and Via Zoom. The meeting was called to order at 8:33 a.m.

ROLL CALL

The following Trustees were in attendance: Mr. Gregory Pinnix, Chair, Mr. John McFayden, Ms. Maya Martin and Mr. Glenn Adams, Ex-Officio. Staff persons in attendance were Mr. Anthony Bennett, Atty. Wanda Jenkins, Coach Richard Hayes and Coach Inez Turner.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

It was moved by Trustee John McFayden and properly seconded by Trustee Pinnix that the minutes of the Athletic Committee Meeting held on September 21, 2022 be accepted as printed and distributed. The motion carried.

ATHLETICS UPDATE

Mr. Antony Bennett, Director of Athletics provided an update on the athletic success of the 2022 fall sports, private donations, and the athletic economic impact study underway by the UNC system. He also added that the department had a very successful fall sports season. Three out of the four fall sport programs won the CIAA Conference championship this year. He gave recognition to Coach Richard Hayes, Head Football Coach and Coach Inez Turner, Head Cross Country/Track and Field Coach.

He stated that Fayetteville State University claimed the men's and women's cross-country championships after claiming the men's 8K title and the women's 5K title at the CIAA Cross Country Championships held at Green Hill Park on Thursday, October 27th. The Broncos won its fifth consecutive women's title and its first men's title while also completing the fir 1-2-3 sweep in CIAA Men's Cross Country Championship history. During the awards ceremony, Hilary Toroitch was named CIAA Men's Cross-Country Athlete of the Year as voted by the CIAA cross country head coaches and sports information directors. Coach Inez Turner of Fayetteville State University was named CIAA Men's and Women's Cross-Country Coach of the Year.

Mr. Bennett stated that Fayetteville State's senior student-athlete Elton Andrew made a 43yard field goal as time expired to give Fayetteville State University a spectacular 31-28 win over Chowan on Saturday, November 12th at Salem Stadium for Fayetteville State's fourth overall and Head Coach Richard Hayes first CIAA Football Championship title.

Mr. Bennett further discussed the athletic department's current funding model and the ideal model which would assist the department with moving towards the vision of being one of the top Division I program in the nation. He also shared the success of the Night of Champions video which culminated to over \$375,000 in committed gifts to FSU Athletics. Keynote speakers of the event were Derrick Whittenburg and Phil Ford, both NCAA national champions and well-known figures in athletics.

Mr. Bennett concluded with an update on the private donations goals and informing the committee of the UNC-system's intent to generate an athletic economic impact study on the 15 state schools with intercollegiate athletic programs.

ADJOURNMENT Trustee Pinnix moved for an adjournment at 8:54 a.m. The motion carried.







DATA SOURCE: NCAA GRADUATION RATES REPORTING SYSTEM




