**SUBJECT** Construction Manager at Risk Selection – Chick &

Rosenthal Building Renovation projects

**BACKGROUND**: The UNC Board of Governors requires the Board of Trustees

to approve the selection of a Construction Manager at Risk ("CM at Risk") upon the constituent institution choosing that method of construction delivery. The CM at Risk guarantees a maximum price (GMP) for a project's cost of construction.

Requests for Qualifications

The closing date for receiving responses from CM at Risk firms was March 30, 2023. The Pre-Selection Committee began its review process at that time.

The University received a total of four submissions in response to the Request for Qualifications.

All four of the respondents were selected for interviews:

- Samet McFarland
- New Atlantic Contracting
- Bordeaux Construction

A Pre-Selection Committee evaluated the proposals and was present for the interviews. The Pre-Selection Committee members are:

- Previous experience with the Owner, a good working relationship with Owner representatives, have completed projects in a timely manner and have performed an acceptable quality of work.
- Key personnel that have appropriate experience and qualifications.
- Relevant and easily understood graphic or tabular presentations.
- Completion of CM-at-Risk projects in which there was little differences between the GMP and final cost.
- Projects that were completed on or ahead of schedule.
- Recent experience with project costs and schedules.
- Construction administration capabilities.
- Proximity to and familiarity with the area where the project is located.
- Quality of compliance plan for minority business participation as required by N.C.G.S. 143-128.2.
