BUGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE Wednesday, June 12, 2024 1:00 PM

The Committee on Budget and Finance of the Fayetteville State University Board of Trustees convened Wednesday, June 12, 2024, in the Rudolph Jones Center Room 242. Committee Chair Stuart Augustine presided and called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m.

ROLL CALL

The following Trustee Committee members were in attendance: Mr. Glenn Adams, Mr. Stuart Augustine, Mr. Donald Moore, and Dr. Kimberly Jefferies Leonard.

Staff persons in attendance were Chancellor Darrell Allison, Dr. Lillian Wanjagi, AVC Gretchen Cobb, AVC Michelle Donegain, Vice Chancellor Dr. Monica Leach, AVC Jon Parsons, AVC Kenny Spayd and AVC Sandra Williams.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Trustee Glenn Adams made a motion to approve the minutes of the Budget and Finance Committee meeting held on March 27, 2024, as distributed. Trustee Dr. Kimberly Jefferies Leonard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

BUDGET AND FINANCE UPDATES

Vice Chancellor Lillian Wanjagi welcomed the committee and introduced Mr. Chris Cary, Associate CIO, to present an update on initiatives within the Division for Information Technology Services. Mr. Cary shared that the classroom modernization project has been a success. Forty-seven classrooms were completed, and an additional thirty-four classrooms are in progress to be completed by July 2024.

Trustee Stuart Augustine asked whether this project would include training for faculty. Mr Cary explained that ITS partnered with the Office of Faculty Development for training the academic departments. Trustee Stuart Augustine also inquired about the educational/technology platform services. Provost Monica Leach shared that we use Canvas as our platform, and we utilize our own IT services for our additional training through the Office of Faculty Development. We also have two instructional designers. The Office of Faculty Development helps with onboarding courses and in the development of their courses as well.

Next, Dr. Lillian Wanjagi introduced Associate Vice Chancellor Jon Parsons to present an update on renovations. Dr. Wanjagi recognized and thanked AVC Parsons 13 years of service.

The Committee on Budget and Finance had two action items discussed.

Action Item: BF-1: New Residence Hall/College of Education Owner's Rep Selection FSU received a total of two proposals in response to a CMR solicitation for the Campus Wide Utility Infrastructure project, in which the interviewed firms were rank ordered.

Trustee Glenn Adams motioned for approval of the selected firm, Reith Jones Advisors, to provide owner's rep services on the New Residence Hall and College of Education projects and authorizes University staff to negotiate a contract and fee with the selected firm. The motion was seconded by Trustee Donald Moore. The motion carried.

Action Item: BF-2: Lyons Science Roof Replacement

FSU received a total of seven proposals in response to a designer solicitation for the Lyons Science Roof project, in which the final interviewed firms were rank ordered.

Trustee Glenn Adams motioned for the approval of the selected firm, Fleming and Associates Engineers, to provide design and engineering services on the Lyons Science Building Roof Replacement project and authorizes University staff to negotiate a contract and fee with the selected firm. The motion was seconded by Trustee Donald Moore. The motion carried.

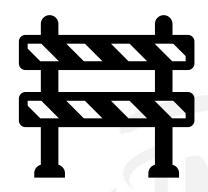
