### COMMITTEE ON UNIVERSITY ADVANCEMENT

### Wednesday, June 12, 2024

### 10:45 AM

The Committee on University Advancement of the Fayetteville State University Board of Trustees convened Wednesday, June 12, 2024, in the Rudolph Jones Student Center, Multi-purpose Room 242 and via Microsoft Teams. The meeting was called to order by Trustee Gregory Pinnix at 10:47 AM.

#### ROLL CALL

The following trustees were in attendance: Mrs. Joyce Adams, Mr. Jerry Gregory, Mr. Gregory Pinnix, and Dr. Kimberly Jeffries Leonard.

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

It was moved by Trustee Pinnix and seconded by Trustee Adams that the minutes of the Committee on University Advancement Meeting held on March 27, 2024, be accepted as printed. The motion carried.

#### UNIVERSITY ADVANCEMENT UPDATES

Mr. Omar Bell, Vice Chancellor for University Advancement, provided an update on fundraising engagement to date.

- The university has raised \$5.78 million dollars.
- In which, over \$2.3 million has been committed.
- 1,171 alumni donors have given overall.

Revenue raised over the last five years show a steady increase, yielding over \$2 million dollars more in this fiscal year 2024 (FY24) than in FY23. University Advancement (UA) is working to increase commitments next fiscal year. The fundraising cycle for FY24 ends in three weeks (June 30<sup>th</sup>). Commitments have surpassed their total giving projection for FY24 by over \$200,000.

The current alumni donors' projection of 1,284 will put the university over 5% for FY24. UA will work towards increasing the alumni donor percentage in coming years by engaging with donors who have given at some point over the years but not during the current fiscal year. UA held a Scholarship and Donor Recognition Dinner on March 28<sup>th</sup>. This dinner connected



donors with scholarship recipients and was also a great networking event. The Golden Broncos from the Class of '74 had '64 participated in the Spring Commencement ceremony— approximately doubling the participation from last year. The Class of '74 has set a goal to raise \$50K in their FSU endowed scholarship by Homecoming 2024.

The Office of Career Services has a new Assistant Vice Chancellor for Career Development and Employer Engagement, Mr. Ralph Simpson. He will work with schools and departments within the university to establish better corporate relationships, among other career development and employer engagement responsibilities.

The three-year goal for paid internships is 750. There are 932 paid internships to date (2021-2024). FSU is well on its way to having 1,000 paid interns. Overall, intern compensation is \$5.6 million. For the 2023-2024 academic year, thus far, paid internships total 388. Revenue projections from internships amount to \$2.5 million. Internships have become a philanthropic selling point in UA.

Chancellor Allison commented on the growth in UA. Last year the division raised a little over \$4 million; this year, a total of \$8.1 million has been raised. Alumni giving has also increased from 3% since he arrived at FSU, and it is still growing. He requested trustees to assist with the 230 alumni donors needed to reach the FY24 goal of 5% and commended VC Bell on his leadership in UA. Trustee Jeffries Leonard extended congratulations to VC Bell for his efforts and said trustees will help with reaching out to alumni. She is also committed to the Board of Trustees having 100% giving for FY24.




