**Trend (2023–2025)**

- 2023: Mixed performance across programs; several areas with lower pass rates and variability
- 2024: Continued variability, with notable low-performing areas (e.g., SPED, Performing Arts)
- 2025: Strong improvement overall, with many programs reaching high pass rates (80–100%) and several at 100%

### **Trend Interpretation**

- 2023 → 2024: Inconsistent performance with identified areas for improvement
- 2024 → 2025: Clear upward trend, with substantial gains across multiple programs
- Indicates program responsiveness and strengthened candidate preparation

### **Key Takeaways**

- Significant improvement in Special Education and Performing Arts from low to high pass rates
- Elementary Education shows steady improvement
- Many Middle Grades and Secondary programs achieved 100% pass rates in 2025
- Some variability remains due to small sample sizes
