

ADVANCED LICENSE GRADUATION RATES AFTER ADMISSION TO GRADUATE DEGREE

For Fall 19 – Spring 20, there were 4 M.Ed. completers, 5 Ed.D. completers (P-12 Track) and 14 MSA completers. The M.Ed. students are part-time students and therefore there is no percentage graduated. The Ed.D P-12 students are admitted in cohorts to a three to four year program. There were five who graduated out of various cohorts of various numbers. The MSA students enter has a cohort with 3 years to complete the program and % finished the program.

INITIAL LICENSE GRADUATION RATES AFTER ADMISSION TO TEACHER EDUCATION

There were 45 student teachers during the Fall 2019-Spring 2020 Semester. One (1) did not complete. The percentage of initial licensure graduates in 2019-20 was 97%.

There were 43 "Traditional Student Teachers" (6 LO, 36 Undergraduate and 1 MAT)

There were 2 "Alternative Student Teachers" (Both were Residency LO; only one completed)

The percentage of the Fall 2019-Spring 2020 Undergraduate Completers graduating in two years of admission to Teacher Education is 94.4%.

There were 36 Undergraduate Completers and 34 of them graduated in two years of admission to TEC.

There were 6 Licensure Only Completers for Fall 2019 - Spring 2020. The percentage of LO completers finishing in two years of admission to TEC was 100%

The 1 MAT Student Teacher (Completer) did NOT graduate within two years of admission to the program (TEC).

The 1 Alternative completer finished the licensure only program within two years of admission to the TEC.
