The report wrote: FSU is the second-oldest state college in North Carolina. The liberal arts university enrolls more than 6,000 students and offers more than 60 degrees. FSU offers several fully online degree completion programs, including a bachelor's of science in criminal justice that is ideal for students planning to pursue careers in law enforcement. The program comprises 120 credit hours, including a 38-hour university core.

The criminal justice curriculum holds certification from the Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences and comprises 82 upper-level credit hours. Students earning the online criminal justice degree explore criminological theory, criminal justice ethics, criminal law, police and society, and prisons and society. Available electives include white collar crime; restorative justice; comparative criminal justice; and sex, sexuality, and the law. Graduates often secure positions as police officers, FBI agents, DEA agents, and crime analysts.

FSU accepts up to 90 transfer credit hours. North Carolina residents pay a fixed tuition rate as long as they maintain continuous enrollment, and 95% of FSU students receive financial aid. Applicants must have at least 24 transferable credit hours, including four prerequisite criminal justice courses; they must also submit college transcripts.
