Failure to submit ALL required verification documents will result in your financial aid offer being delayed.

Instruction Section for Tax Filers and Non-Filers

Option 1 - Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT)

The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®). If you have already used this tool and submitted your FAFSA® with unaltered tax data, then no further action is required, unless instructed by our office.

If you have not already used this tool, go to studentaid.gov log into your FAFSA® and select 'Make FAFSA Corrections.' Navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.

Option 2 - Request an IRS Tax Return Transcript for Filers or a Verification of Non-Filing Letter for Non-Filers

If you do not meet the requirements or choose not to use the IRS DRT, you are required to submit your IRS Tax Return Transcript to our office. If you did not file taxes, you will need to request a 2021 Verification of Non-Filing Letter from the IRS>

To obtain an IRS Tax Return Transcript, go to www.irs.gov and click on the "Get a Tax Transcript" link. You can select to receive the transcript online or have a copy mailed to you. You will need your Social Security Number, date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS (the address used when your 2021 IRS tax return was filed) or call 1-800-908-9946.

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
