





ScholarshipUniverse Instructions Guide



- The more questions you ask, the more scholarships you will be matched to.




Sidebar Menu Overview

The Sidebar Menu can be used to navigate ScholarshipUniverse.

- **The Dashboard** is your home base. This shows you an overview of your scholarship matches and will remind you if you have additional opportunities to answer questions.
- **The Questions tab** will link you to your personalized questionnaire, where you answer questions to match you with outside scholarship opportunities.
- **The Scholarships tab** will link you to a list of scholarships you have matched to. You can also view other lists of scholarships such as Pinned, Application Submitted, and Partial Matches.
- **The Feedback tab** allows you send Feedback to Scholarship Universe.



The Scholarships screen has several tabs that you review:

- Matches - List of scholarships that the student has met all the matching requirements.
- Pinned - List of scholarships that the student has pinned to their account using the button on an individual scholarship listed.
- Partial Matches - List of scholarships where the student has met at least one requirement, but not all the matching requirements.
- Application Submitted - List of internal scholarship applications a student has submitted.
- Awarded - List of internal scholarships for which the student has been awarded.
- Non-Matches - List of scholarships for which the student does not meet the matching requirements.
- Not Interested - List of scholarships that the student has marked themselves as not interested in by using the no symbol on an individual scholarship.



Step 4: View and apply for Scholarships!



- To read more about the scholarships, click on the “View” button. To open the scholarship website in a new tab and apply directly, click the “Apply” button.
- You can save scholarships to review later, review scholarship statistics, or mark scholarships as “not interested” through the buttons on the right of each scholarship.
