FACULTY AND STAFF

- 270 full-time teaching faculty (using AAUP criteria) are employed as of October 1, 2013.
- 87% of full-time faculty members hold doctoral or first professional degrees.
- The average salary of a full-time faculty member is \$76,174 for men and \$74,713 for women.
- Student-to-faculty ratio is approximately 17 to 1.
