FACULTY AND STAFF

- 256 full-time teaching faculty (using AAUP criteria) are employed as of October 1, 2016.
- 84% of full-time faculty members hold doctoral or first professional degrees.
- The average salary of a full-time faculty member is \$81,092 for men and \$78,650 for women.
- Student-to-faculty ratio is approximately 18 to 1.
