North Carolina Teaching Fellows Quick Facts

- Statewide Competitive Loan Forgiveness Program in NC
- Students can receive up to \$5,000.00 per semester based upon the cost of tuition, books, and fees at each partner institution
- Study and build community at one of ten NCTF Partner Institutions!
- If selected as a recipient, **for each year** you receive funding you must teach STEM, Special Education, or Elementary Education in a NC public school (traditional or charter)
- Eligible Initial Licensure Areas
 - STEM Education (Middle or High School Agricultural, Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math Education)
 - Special Education (General or Adaptative Curriculum)
 - Elementary Education (Traditional K-6 classroom)
- **Pathways to NCTF:** Reach out directly to each partner institution to learn more about their campus NCTF program and admission requirements.
 - NC High School Senior Eligible to receive up to 8 semesters of funding
 - Internal Transfer Eligible to receive up to 4 semesters of funding
 - External Transfer Eligible to receive up to 6 semesters of funding
 - Post Bachelor (Already Graduated with a Bachelor's Degree)
 Eligible to receive up to 4 semesters of funding or the cost of a licensure only program.

What You Need to Apply

- Before beginning, make sure you have the following to complete your application!
- Personal information including Social Security Number
- High School or College Transcript in PDF format (unofficial is acceptable for application)
- (2) letters of recommendation in PDF format
 - Unfortunately, due to our current application platform, you must find references who can email them to you in a pdf format.
- One (1) from an academic reference (counselor, teacher, administrator, etc.)
- One (1) from a personal or additional academic reference (not a family member)
- Answers to 3 essay questions in complete sentences. Visit ncteachingfellows.org to get the questions ahead of time!
