









Methods classes were only offered in the fall and student teaching in spring, so many had to wait an extra year to be eligible to graduate since they were originally december graduates.









Satisfaction with Major 803





There are significant issues with customer service across various campus programs, particularly in the financial aid office and dining services, including the main cafeteria, Rudolph Jones Dining Hall, and Bronco Grill. The dining hall and grill staff, while some are okay, most, exhibit poor customer service. Employees often arrive late, display dismissive attitudes, and, in some cases, appear unwilling to engage with students respectfully.

The Bronco Grill's operational inconsistency is especially concerning. It frequently opens later than scheduled, leaving students without reliable meal options. Given that students depend on these services, there must be a higher standard of accountability for staff timeliness and professionalism.

Additionally, sanitation standards in the dining areas are unacceptable. Tables are often unclean, and the drink machines frequently malfunction, making it difficult for students to access basic amenities. The lack of proper cleanliness not only diminishes the dining experience but also raises potential health concerns.

As paying students, we deserve efficient, respectful, and reliable campus services. I strongly urge the administration to implement stricter oversight, employee training, and enforcement of service standards to improve these critical areas. Accountability measures, better staff management, and regular cleanliness inspections should be prioritized to ensure a positive and functional campus experience for all students.





I also had a few issues with constant changing academic advisors and without notice. I got lucky and a friend recommended a staff member who has been tremendous, but I know a ton of students who have had issues with advising, lastly, parking services always gave me trouble, regardless of what residence building I was associated with. I think paying so much for a parking pass and not being able to find parking on campus is a issue, especially if you work odd hours and or at night, meaning you may have to park far from your dorm, or in a undesignated area and risk getting another ticket. When I had issues with this, I did not get much guidance and often faced traffic tickets or parking tickets because I had no other areas to park.

Participated in commencement in Spring to find that I can't get the degree until I finish the other degree in Fall. Whole situation could've been avoided with a more knowledgeable advisor.

Many online websites through the FSU webpage lead to inactive webpages.

The advisors I have had over the years haven't made this the easiest time for me. A lot of mistakes were made and I took classes I didn't need to on top of having to figure most things out by myself.

Academic advisors - they rarely answer emails or phones, leaving you to plan classes on your own or beg other advisors  
Professors - Some are great, others are unavailable, and others are extremely rude and condescending. Please look at the rate my teachers - it is very correct about the professors at Fayetteville state

Having a single Hub that brings in Navigate, Banner, Dashboard, and Outlook into one space. I have had too many places to log in, and the information was not complete.

The parking needs a lot of work. People consistently complain and there are several times outside the student center where parking is almost impossible to find without having to walk all the way across campus.

A lot of issues over my time at FSU with advisors and quite a few professors. Such as hard to reach, guiding me in the wrong direction, attitude, etc.

Professionalism

-My academic advising experience within the psychology department has been pretty up-and-down when I transferred here. I started with Dr. Amyn-Kalik (I hope I spelled his name correctly) during Spring 2023, and he has retired now. However, during my time with him he has been spoken to me pretty rudely until I introduced him to my father at the open house, and informed him that I do speak to my dad about everything that I do throughout my college career. He spoke very highly of me to my father, but was rude and unorganized when I needed guidance with him. Now, I have Miss Yolanda Davis, who I do enjoy talking to and wish her well with her academic successes. I am disappointed with the fact that I had to seek another advisor to initially start my graduation application process because she had sent out an email to me, and other students within the psychology department informing us that we do not need to see her regarding graduation appointments. Also, she expressed having appointments virtually instead of in-person when in-person options are still provided. I understand that she has other obligations, but it is frustrating that I felt like my concerns were not being met until I reached out to her to let her know that I went to someone else for help, but still needed to see her.

-Online courses. I have been a fully online student for the remainder of my senior year due to the courses only being provided online. It is somewhat difficult for me because the professors hold us students to a standard of following deadlines, turning things in on time, and figuring out how to balance classes, our jobs, and life regardless of what happens. I currently have a professor who does not accept late work, unless there is an excused absence in certain circumstances, or there was a malfunction that the class notified her about. However, she took a trip to Dubai and was behind on our grades. When she came back, she scheduled a week or two's worth of assignments to be due in a small amount of time --- right before midterms. It was very stressful trying to cram these assignments in when they were dropped in the middle of the week, and she was two weeks behind on our grades and we did not receive ample amount of time to complete on top of the rest of the assignments that we may have had. If we have to treat online courses like it is real school, I would want my professors to treat these classes like they are just as serious too.

Academic advising

I had an instructor tell me it was against the law. She was very rude. Definitely need to learn how to speak to students and a little more caring. I could go on but this is the worst school I have ever attended

Health Services: I had an ongoing health issue that led to me having multiple appointments at the health center; however, the staff passed judgment on me and made me feel uncomfortable. When I visited an outside doctor, I had a serious problem that should have been addressed and not looked down upon by the medical professionals at the center.

Advising: I was not told that I needed three more credits to graduate until a few weeks before graduation, and there were no available classes for me to take so that I could graduate on time. I went into the semester thinking I was on track. Being as though there are not many seniors in my major, I feel like ensuring all seniors were on track to graduate, credit and class checks should have been something that was communicated to me by my advisor before it was too late.

If I did not work at a college and understand the course registration process, my experience with my advisor would have caused me drop out. They were wholly unprofessional in communication towards me and often rude. I work with two academic advisors, and if they treated their students received some of the emails I received from my advisor at FSU I am not sure they would hold the position they do currently.

Also I wish FSU used the same information for all of their websites. It's always a hassle trying to get through outlook, and microsoft's authentication process. Then my log in for banner is different from my log in for dining services and to make an FSU payment. I wish the technology was simpler. Its very complex right now and a lot to have to keep up with when I'm just trying to do school work and sure my school bills are paid.

The incorporation of the new book program this year caused me a lot of needless stress for my last year, especially my last semester. I did not have access to one of my books for the first few weeks. Additionally, the platform is slow and had several technical issues. I ended up spending money out of pocket to purchase some of my books myself so that I would have a hard copy because the system lacked dependability.

Advising for the RN to BSN online program was abysmal. However, since Elizabeth Abruzzese has taken over in the position, it has improved greatly.

There was a webinar about graduation in late October/early November and those leading the webinar did not even know at the time if tickets would be required. Fast forward to mid/late November and I find out that tickets are not only required, but that, as of 12/4/24 (a mere NINE days before graduation), there is no plan on how to distribute tickets to online students who are traveling to graduation and are unable to pick up their tickets in person prior to rehearsal on 12/12/24. That, to me, is unacceptable to have forgotten about an entire demographic of students paying thousands of dollars in tuition to be an afterthought. I spoke with two women in the Registrar's Office, both of whom were absolutely lovely to deal with (Ms. Sampson was one of them) and they were so kind, but relayed that the "higher ups" were making that decision about IF tickets would be available to online students unable to attend rehearsal. Both times I called, it was mentioned that there would be "overflow" in another arena where family members could watch, but why on earth would I spend \$20,000 dollars, have my family TRAVEL to watch me graduate, and then ask them to go to another facility for "over flow" seating all because no one thought about how to get online students their 4 graduation tickets. Unacceptable and highly disappointing in my personal opinion.

I attempted to contact the veterans services on multiple occasions during the noted hours of operations and never once did anyone answer the phone.










